Booth Operation & Information

Scandinavian Heritage Festival Booth Guidelines

In order to observe an orderly and professional atmosphere, we ask you abide by the following:

1. Applicants may sell only those items described on their applications and/or approved by the Committee. The Scandinavian Festival Committee reserves the right to disallow the display of any item that in their judgment is inappropriate.
2. Applications must be received by May 7th, 2010. If an individual's application cannot be accepted all fees will be returned.
3. All booths need to be in operation during the festival. Booths will need to be set up by Friday at noon and open until dark that evening. We will start again on Saturday at 9:00 am and run until 6:00 pm.
4. Vendors are responsible for overnight security. The Scandinavian Festival will not be responsible for loss or theft of items left in booths.
5. Vendors will provide their own tables, chairs, counters, display boards, tarp, etc. No electricity will be provided for craft booths unless stated on application and paid for. Booths are set up on the streets; therefore vendors will need to provide weight to secure booths down.
6. The Scandinavian Festival strives to represent our Scandinavian heritage, and gives you the option of decoration your booth in that motif or dressing in Scandinavian clothing.
7. The Scandinavian Festival takes place regardless of the weather. Please prepare accordingly.
8. Vendors are responsible for removing trash and debris from their booth spaces.
- 9. Vendors are required to pay a refundable \$50.00 cleaning deposit. If space is left clean of trash and debris your deposit will be refunded to you ASAP. Please check out with a festival committee member before leaving.**
10. We ask that you leave your pets at home. Pets are prohibited by order of the Ephraim City Council; it is a city ordinance.
11. The sale of any food item in the craft area is prohibited. Food booths are located in a different area.
12. The Scandinavian Festival Committee, Ephraim City and Snow College will not be liable for property damage, loss or personal injury to anyone participating in any way in the Scandinavian Festival.
